

0-6 OUTFIT MODELS 1908 – 1916

These tables show all the Meccano models in the main manuals between 1908 and early 1916 (both Liverpool and America) and how the model numbers changed during the period and also if the model was redesigned. They also show if the model (or a similar one) was kept in the next era 1916-21 manuals. Note that there are no known Liverpool manuals published in 1915 and the 1914 manual continued in use. However there are American Outfit 0 and No.14 manuals which can be dated to 1915 due to their changed contents. These have the same models as normal 1914 manuals, but the motors are different. In early 1916 a 14S manual was published to accompany the remaining stocks of the 1914 manual which had pages cut out and new pages stuck in. This was a temporary measure before the new 1916 manuals were published. The Liverpool and American 14S manuals are completely different.

Notes:-

- 1) The number in the 'After' column is the equivalent model number in the 1916 manual (except where otherwise noted).
- 2) (D) against an 'After' model number shows that there was a relatively minor change. Often this was to use the different parts that were included in the outfits to improve the model.
- 3) (M) against an 'After' model number shows that there was a major or complete redesign of the model. Often the only similarity was the name of the model.
- 4) (P) against an 'After' model number shows that the model was unchanged, but the model picture was touched up.
- 5) The first 1909 manual did not include models 21, 38, 39, 56, 57 and 62. These extra models were initially published in a supplementary manual. This supplementary manual was later included by being bound in to the rear of the main manual. Following this a further edition of the 1909 manual was published with the additional models fully incorporated into the manual in the correct order.
- 6) Many new models were initially published in the No.13 Supplementary manual in late 1913/early 1914 using several newly introduced parts. All these models were subsequently included in the main 1914 manual. It is assumed that the No.13 Supplementary manual was published as an interim measure for use in the new 1914 outfits along with the remaining 1913 manuals in order to use these up. As this was wartime, paper would be scarce.
- 7) The models were not numbered in the No.13 Supplementary manual, so a '*' along with the page number on which the model appeared is put in the table below.
- 8) Most of the outfit 0 (Meccano Royal) models were also outfit 1 models. The additional column in the 0 outfit table shows the equivalent number in the 1914 main 1-6 outfit manual.
- 9) The models were not numbered in the 14S manual, so a '*' along with the page number on which the model appeared is put in the table below.
- 10) A number of the 14S models originally appeared in the 1914/15 Prize Models Manual. These are noted along with the page number on which they appeared.
