HOW TO BUILD BIGGER MODELS

The Meccano No. 00 Outfit is the first step in the Meccano system. After you have made all the models shown in the 00 Manual you will want to build bigger models. You may do this by adding new parts to your No. 00 Outfit or, by purchasing a No. 00a Accessory Outfit (price 1/6), you may convert your No. 00 Outfit into a No. 0. The extra parts in this Outfit enable you to build many more models and to obtain even greater pleasure from Meccano.

MECCANO ACCESSORY OUTFITS

It is important to remember that each Outfit may be converted into the one next higher by means of an Accessory Outfit. Your 00 Outfit is converted into a No. 0 by adding to it a No. 00a. A No. 0a will then convert it into a No. 1 and so on. In this manner, no matter with which Outfit you commence, you may gradually build it up until you are the proud possessor of a No. 7 Outfit.
