



The building instructions given on the other side of this sheet for No. 1 Outfit apply also to No. 2 Outfit. For convenience they are repeated below.


Instructions for No. 2 Outfit

The simplest method of connecting a series of Dink y Builder Plates together to construct a model is first to lay out the necessary parts, hinges upward, on a flat surface, in the positions they will occupy in the completed model. (See Fig. 2 on the other side of this sheet). The Rods are then inserted, the special tool supplied with the to push them in. other side of this sheet).

It is sometimes necessary to bring the hinges of two separate Plates into line before the Rod is inserted. In such cases the task of lining up will be greatly simplified by using the tool in the manner of a "drift."


That is to say, it is pushed through the hinges so that they are brought into line, and is then withdrawn.




HOW TO INCREASE THE REALISM


A feature of unfailing interest is the miniature table lamp supplied with the No. 2 Outfit. This adds greatly to the realism of the furniture groups. It should be lighted from a 4 volt pocket battery (not included in the Outfit).


Miniature carpets of any desired shape can be cut from velvet or other suitable material for use with the furniture groups. When appropriate colours are chosen, really charming results can be obtained that greatly enhance the attractiveness of the models.











Instructions for No. I Outfit


Meccano Dinky Builder Plates are hinged on all sides, with intervening spaces, so that when two are placed side by side the hinged part of one Plate fits into the corresponding space in the other. A Rod can be pushed through the complete hinge, and in this manner any number of Plates can be built up to form various geometrical shapes.

The simplest method of connecting a series of Plates together to construct a model is first to lay out the necessary parts, hinges utward, on a flat surface, in




models. (See Fig. 2). The Rods are then inserted, the special tool supplied with the Outfit being used to push them in. (See Fig. 1.)


