HOLE DIAMETER Possibly about 1/8". HOLE SPACING Varies but probably 1" to 1½" in most Strips.

SETS IN SYSTEM One only.

DIFFERENT PARTS 34.

COLOUR Wooden parts painted black, bright red, green, yellow or orange.

FIXING METHOD Nut and bolt - 4-36. Some parts push-fit on axles

MOTORS None.

PERIOD Known in 1927 and 1928

MANUFACTURER Hustler Toy Corporation, Sterling, Illinois. U.S.A.

COMMENTS Steel strips/brackets/axles and wooden wheels/base/circular parts.

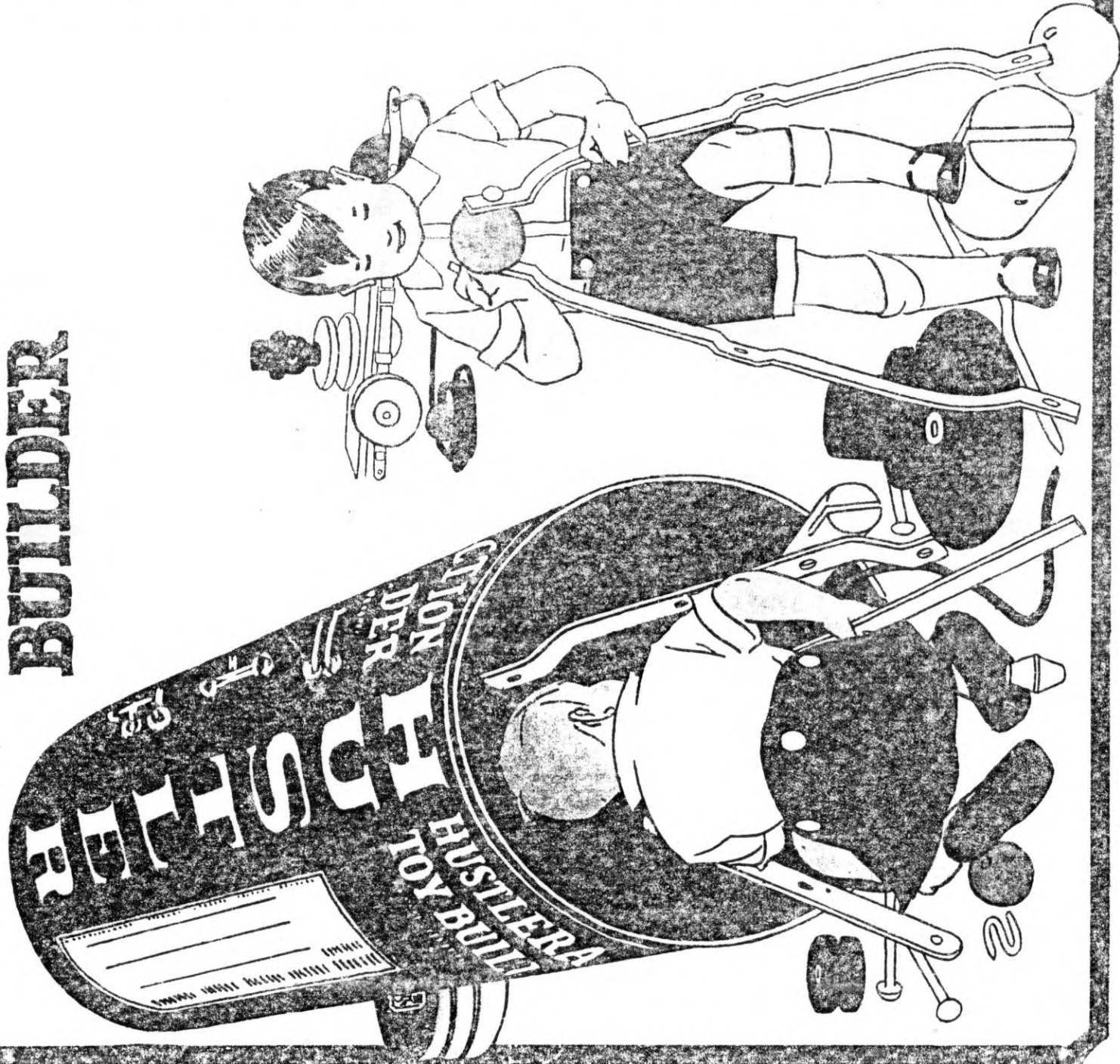

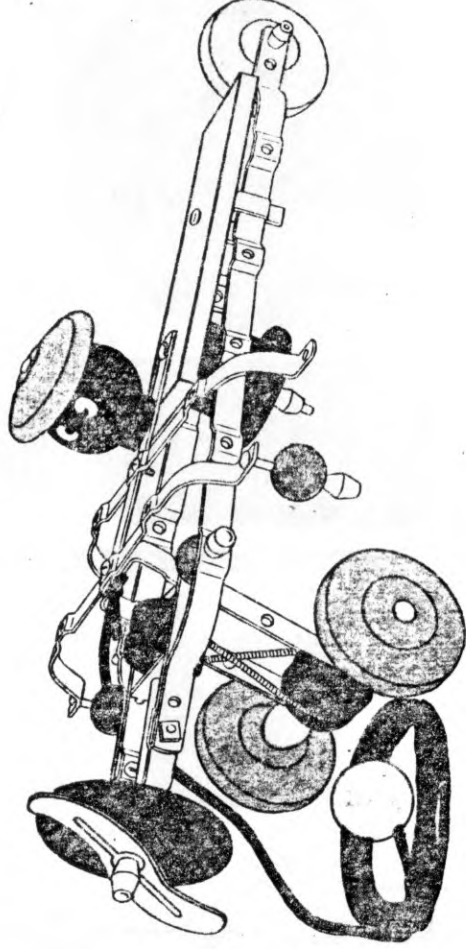
WRECKING CRANE



Take two pieces No. 1 and fasten with No. 13 through holes *B*. Place No. 5 between two pieces No. 1 and fasten with No. 13 through holes *H-S-H*. Take two pieces No. 2 placing one on each side of No. 5 and fasten with No. 13 through holes *L-U-L*. Insert No. 10 through holes *F-J-J-F*; next slip No. 26 over No. 10. Insert No. 10 through hole *N*-No. 22-hole *V*; next slip No. 26 over No. 10. Insert No. 28 through hole *E*-No. 22-hole *E*; next slip No. 26 over No. 28. Take ordinary piece of cord about 18 inches long and fasten one end to No. 17 and wrap other end around No. 22 and tie. Insert No. 11 through No. 14-No. 4 and slip No. 26 over No. 11; next clamping completed unit in place over both pieces No. 1 between holes *D* and *E*. Insert No. 9 through No. 18-No. 15-holes *C*-No. 15-No. 18. Insert No. 9 through No. 18-No. 15-hole *G*-No. 14-hole *G*-No. 15-No. 18. Insert one end No. 29 through holes *A* and knot. Thread other end of No. 29 through No. 14 and knot.

AEROPLANE

Take two pieces No. 1 and part No. 3 fastening with No. 13 through holes *A* and *P* on both sides. Insert No. 11 through hole *I*-No. 18 hole *I* and slip No. 26 over end of No. 11. Spread ends of No. 3 and enter ends of No. 6 in holes *Q*. Insert No. 9 through No. 26-hole *C*-No. 15-hole *R*-holes *P*-hole *R*-No. 15-hole *C* and slip No. 26 over end of No. 9. Insert No. 8 through No. 18-No. 16-hole *R*-No. 22-hole *R*-No. 16-No. 18. Insert No. 12 through hole *X*-hole in No. 4 and slip No. 26 over end of No. 12. Clamp No. 4 over both No. 1 between holes *G* and *F*. Insert No. 10 through hole *V*-hole *W*-No. 24 and slip No. 26 over end of No. 10. Fasten No. 2 to No. 3 with No. 13 through holes *L-S-O*. Insert No. 11 through holes *J-V*-No. 15 and slip No. 26 over end of No. 11. Attach No. 2 to No. 5 with No. 13 through holes *L-T*. Insert No. 10 through No. 18-No. 23 hole *U* and slip No. 26 over end of No. 10. Insert No. 9 through No. 26-No. 33-No. 19-hole *O* in No. 3-hole in No. 6 and slip No. 22 over end of No. 9. Place No. 34 around both No. 22, attach ends and place in grooves. Attach one end of No. 29 around No. 13 and between No. 5 and No. 3 and knot. Thread other end of No. 29 through No. 14 and knot.
