

SUPPLEMENTARY INSTRUCTIONS

The long pointed rod, known as a drift, included in the Outfit, is for the purpose of assisting the assembly of a model by bringing into alignment holes through which a bolt is to be passed.

The pointed end of the drift is inserted into the holes and pressed forward with a slight, side-to-side motion. The effect of this is to pull the holes into alignment so that a bolt may be easily inserted.
