JUNIOR SET. This set consists of 107 component parts, all in Multi-Colour Minibrix. As its name implies, it is intended for the toddler. Among the models that can be built with this set are a dog, a diver, a baby tank, etc. See inside for illustrations.



# How to Build with

A complete building system in miniature with all-rubber, self-locking bricks.

#### REAL BUILDING IN MINIATURE

When you build with Minibrix, you are working on similar lines to real builders. Minibrix is architecturally correct. The models and diagrams have been drawn up under the supervision of a leading architect, the late Mr. W. A. T. Carter, A.R.I.B.A. Thus, besides being a practical and fascinating pastime. Minibrix is also an instructional hobby. It teaches the rudiments of architecture, the elements of building, develops skill and inventiveness, and helps you to work out problems for yourself. The Minibrix system of building construction is based on the wonderful Minibrix miniature rubber building bricks with their simple and effective self-locking device. With these bricks, and the other miniature building materials included in each set, any number of realistic models of houses, cottages, bridges, railway stations, as well as true-to-life models of famous buildings may be built.

These rubber building materials are made to scale and are supplied in all forms required for real building—whole bricks, half bricks, angle bricks, etc., in brick-red in the standard Minibrix sets, and black and white in the Tudor sets, all of which fit firmly together by means of the patent self-locking device.

You will notice on looking at the bricks that they have studs on one side and holes on the other. By simply pressing the studs of one brick into the holes of the next, the bricks snap firmly into position, yet may easily be taken apart. Note too that the lintels, which are used mainly for foundations and for door and window sills have holes on both sides, but no studs. The tiny holes in the lintels and bricks are for fitting the doors and windows, which can be made to open and shut in the most life-like manner. Lintels may, if necessary, be locked or fastened to other building components by the use of universal pins, which become in effect "studs".

The toddler can make lovely models in pastel shades with the attractive Junior Set, while for the older child the No. I Set is designed for beginners in real model building. Larger sets contain such special parts as fluted Corinthian pillars, balustrades and universal pins. These are used to lock components together where the studs are not available.

With Tudor - Minibrix sets one can build models of the charming half-timbered cottages, houses, manors, etc.

### NOTE TO PARENTS

Being made of high quality rubber, the bricks cannot scratch furniture; neither will they chip or break off. Minibrix is hygienic throughout, the components are washable and almost everlasting and may be passed on from one child to another. The entire outfit is perfectly safe and may be placed with absolute confidence in the hands of the youngest child.

This picture shows how easily the allrubber bricks fit together. The slightest pressure only is required to make the studs go into the holes. and they hold firmly and may be pulled apart without effort. This self-locking device is patented and an exclusive Minibrix feature.
